Stations of the Cross is a historic tradition that originated from the Via Dolorosa. Each station marks a different part of the crucifixion story, allowing us to symbolically walk the same path as Jesus during his crucifixion.

Starting from the first station and ending at the last station, start by saying a prayer of understanding and meditation. Read the scripture associated with each station, and spend some time thinking about each question before moving onto the next station.

Jesus Is Arrested:

Sanhedrin Tries Jesus:

Mark 14: 61-64

What does Christ as the Messiah mean to you?

Pilate Tries Jesus:

John 18: 33-38

How does Truth affect the World? How does truth affect you?





## 5. Brooks Gym

Pilate Sentences Jesus:

Mark 15: 6-15

What is it like to go along with the crowd? When have you been in Pilate's shoes and taken the easy way out?



## 6. Mini-Dome

Jesus Wears a Crown:

John 19: 5

Why is it important that Jesus was fully human?



## 7. Conifer Garden

Jesus Carries His Cross:

John 10: 17-18

Where do you need to pull from God's strength in the coming days?



## 8. Brown Hall Garden

Simon Carries the Cross:

Luke 23: 26

Who has walked alongside you in life's darkest moments? Who are you called to walk with during theirs?





## 9. Carillon

Jesus Speaks to the Women:

Luke 23: 27-31

What sorrows and mourning do you have to bring up to God?



## 10. Reece Museum

Jesus is Crucified:

Luke 23: 33-34

Who do you need to forgive?



## 11. Sherrod Library

Criminals Speak to Jesus:

Luke 23: 33-34

In what ways have you sinned and need to ask for forgiveness of?



## 12. Tri-Hall Field Pavillion

Jesus Speaks to Mary and John:

John 19: 25-27

Who has cared for you? Who has been your family?

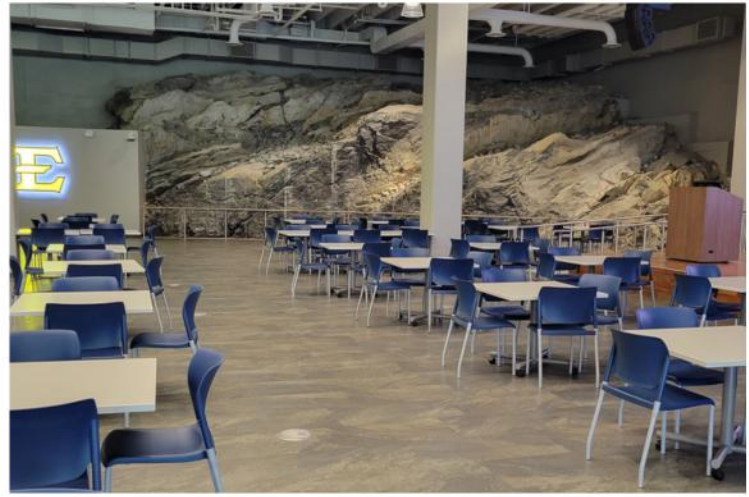


## 13. Culp Cave
